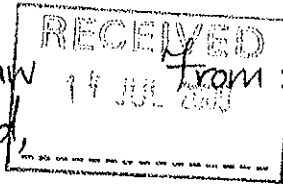

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to you with regard to my experience with Just For Kids Law.

When my 7-year-old son, [REDACTED] was permanently excluded from primary school, I found that there was no financially accessible legal advocacy service, with a specialist knowledge of Educational law, any nearer to where I live than London. I was given, during the course of my enquiries, the telephone number of Just For Kids Law. I got straight through to a person, rather than a machine, and was able to leave a brief explanation of what my problems were. I was informed that I would receive a call from a solicitor within 48 hours, and, duly, 2 days later I received the call from Laura Orger, who's manner and understanding provided me with the essential help and support that I desperately needed at a very painful time of social and authoritarian rejection.

Laura provided excellent advice and advocacy, and also organized representation by a barrister, during the

run-up to the Independent Appeal Panel Hearing last month. And without her support my family's lives would be in a much darker place today.

The Independent Appeal Panel overturned the permanent exclusion and the Local Authorities are now having to take [REDACTED] real needs and issues much more seriously. Without the representation of Stephen Broach, the barrister, and all of Laura's hard work and advocacy, I doubt that there would have been such a positive outcome for [REDACTED] and myself.

A request for a Statutory Assessment, which Laura also made on my behalf, is now in the beginning stages of being considered, and [REDACTED] and I can look forward to a more enlightened educational experience in a better school, without the unfair slur on his school record of a permanent exclusion to blight his future learning opportunities.

I am a single mother on benefits, with two sons with Special Educational Needs, and I can not afford usual legal fees. But our rights to justice and fair-play are no less valid as human beings than those of others. Without Laura Orger, and all of you at Just For Kids Law, and the essential work that you do for mis-understood and unfairly treated children and young people, who embody so much of all our futures, I would not have been able to achieve justice for [REDACTED] and, long-term, hopefully, by this achievement, for other children. The Law is there, and the sooner individuals within the teaching, Social Services and other Local Authority professions realize that they can not flout it with impunity, simply because

of their professional status, the better life will be for all.

The work that Laura Orger does with Just For Kids Law provides a vital voice for parents of children, and for young people, to have the opportunity to stand up for themselves and be heard.

So, I would just like to express my deep and enduring appreciation to Just For Kids Law, and Laura Orger in particular, for all the help, support and advocacy that I have received at one of the most difficult times in my life, I couldn't have got through it without you. Keep up the good work!
